


## 1. ACM Digital Library

- i. Select **ACM Ref** from the required **ACM** article


## 2. Discovery

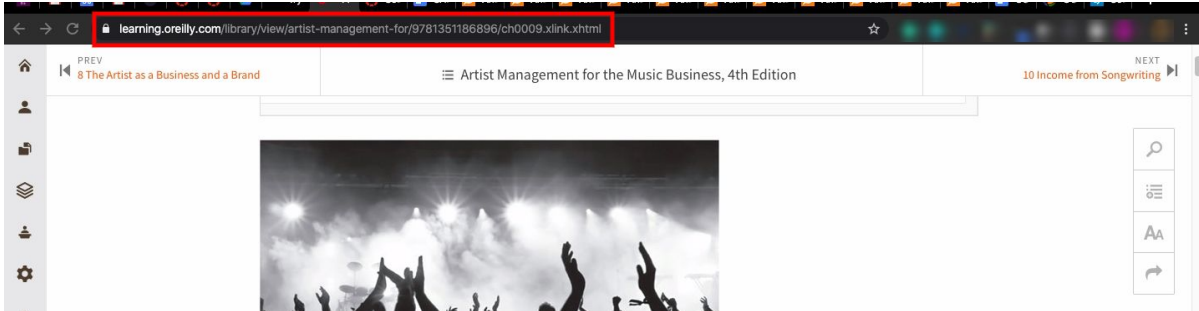
- ii. Copy the URL

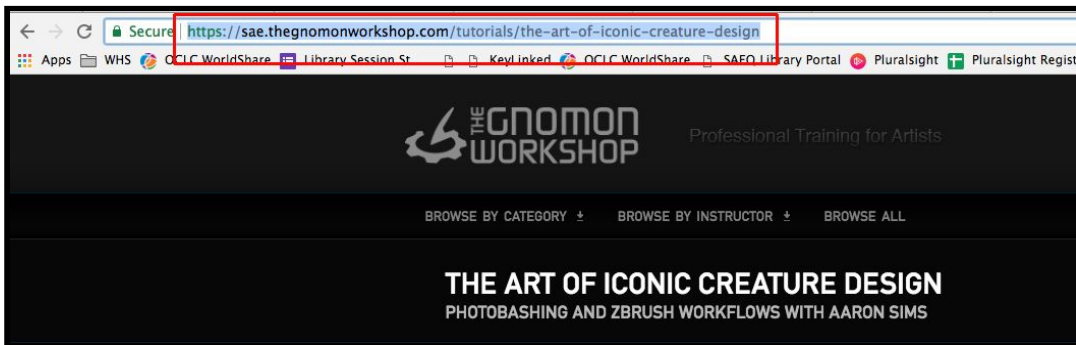
### 3. Safari Books Online

- ii. Locate and select the title of the book, chapter, learning path or playlist
- iii. Copy the URL from the browser



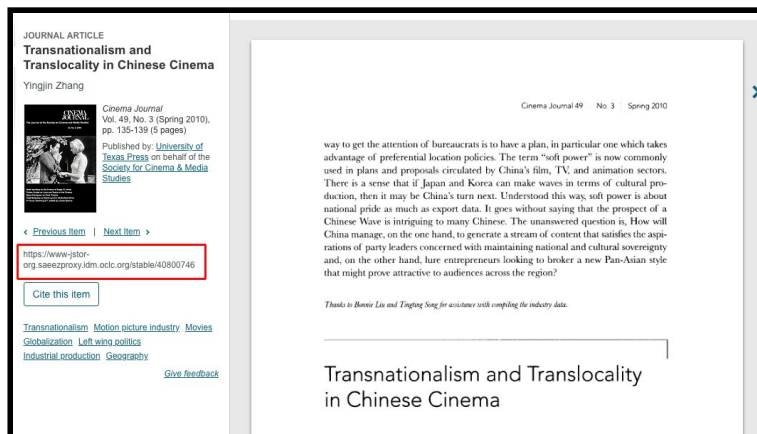
### 4. Gnomon

- ii. Locate and select the title of the tutorial
- iii. Copy the URL from the browser



### 5. JSTOR

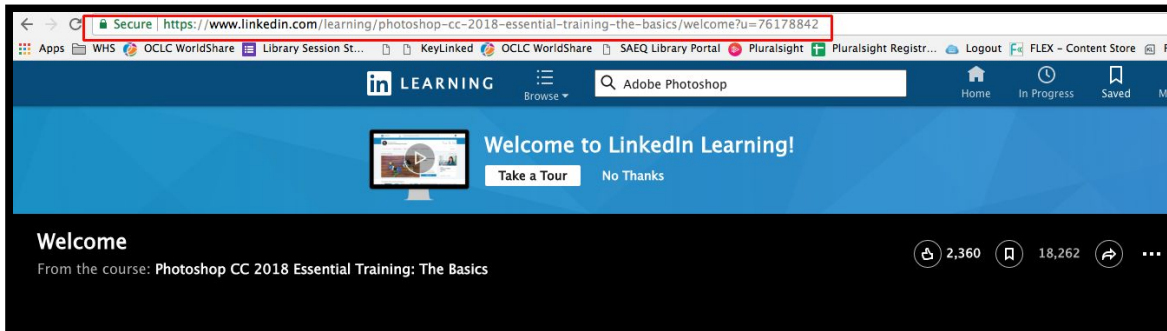
- i. From the relevant [JSTOR](#) article, locate and copy the **stable URL**

- ii. Locate and select the title of the tutorial
- iii. Copy the URL from the browser



- iv. Type the following at the end of the tutorial link **&auth=true**

- iii. Right click and Copy the URL from the title of the course



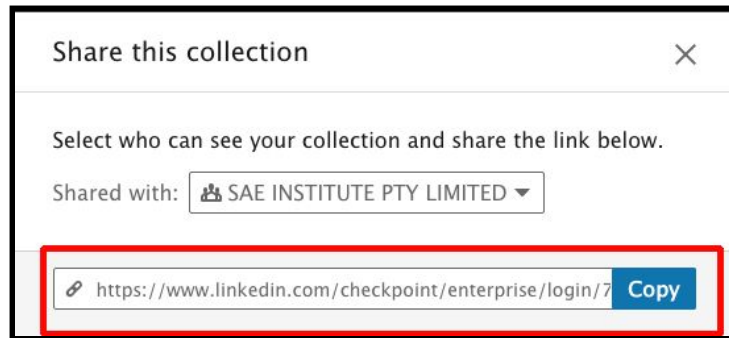
- iv. Type the following at the end of your course link **&auth=true**

- iv. Copy the secure link.

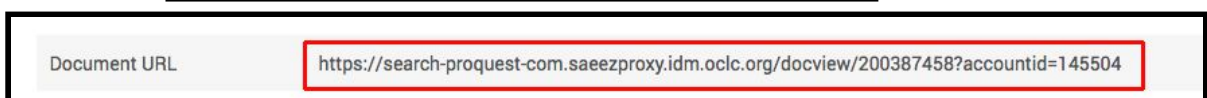

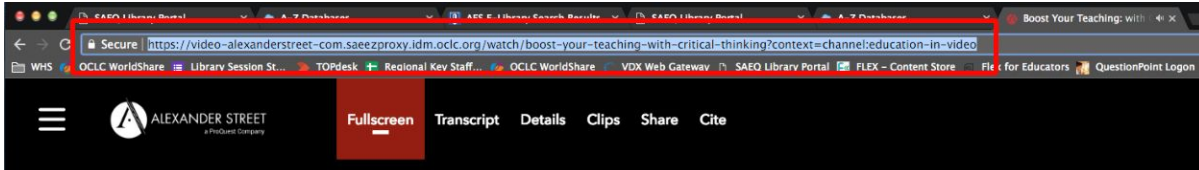

- i. From the relevant Proquest article, locate and copy the Document URL from the **Abstract/Details** tab.



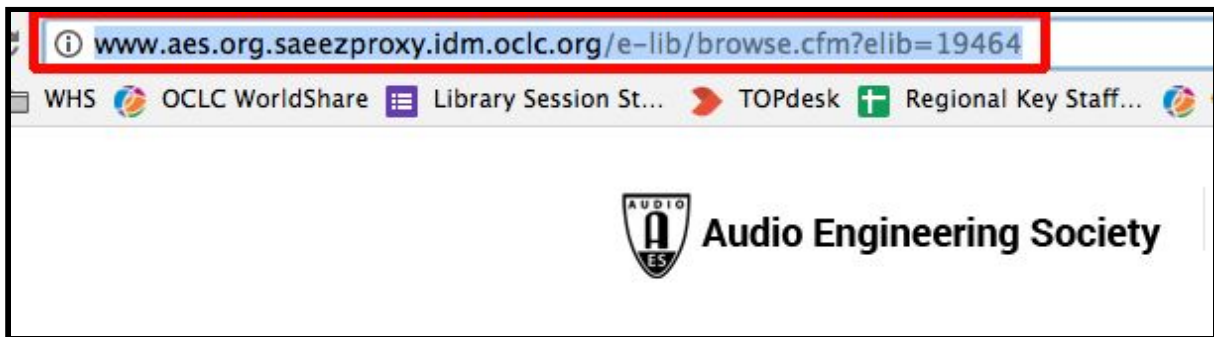
